I, Charles Black Sheriff of Noble County, in the State of Indiana, certify that I have this day sold by virtue of a certified copy of judgment and decree and order of sale to me directed from the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Noble County, Indiana, issued on the 17th day of February, 19 22, in a case wherein Grant A. Kimmell

plaintiff and Irene E. Hoffman and John Hoffman were defendant s wherein judgment was rendered on the 7th day of January, 19 22 for the sum of Nineteen Hundred Thirty Five dollars and Fourteen cents, principal and interest to date of judgment, and the further sum of Eighteen dollars and Sixty-two cents, costs accrued to that date, upon which there has accrued Twelve dollars and Ninety cents interest and eight cents costs making in all Nineteen Hundred Fifty dollars and two cents principal and interest, and Fifty Eight dollars and Eighty-four cents cost to date of sale; making total amount due Two Thousand Sixteen dollars and Eighty-six cents
