I, *Samuel Braden Jr.* Sheriff of *Stable* County, in the State of Indiana, certify that I have this day sold by virtue of *certified copy of judgment, decree and order of sale* to me directed from the Clerk of *Circuit* Court of *Stable* County, Indiana, issued on the *9th* day of *April* 1886, in a case wherein plaintiff and *Aquilla & Jones* is *Edward Stoy and Loretta Stoy* are
