

Sheriff's Certificate of Sale of Execution.

I, William Hoffman Sheriff of Noble County, in the STATE OF INDIANA, certify that I have this day sold, by virtue of Order of Sale to me directed from the Clerk of the Whitley Circuit Court of Whitley County, Indiana in a case wherein The Lincoln National Life Insurance Company was Plaintiff, and Gabriel T.
