

SHERIFF'S CERTIFICATE OF SALE.

I, Daniel Braden Jr., Sheriff of Noble County, in the State of Indiana, certify that I have this day sold by virtue of an Execution to me directed from the Clerk of the Superior Court of Noble County, Indiana, issued on the 6th day of June 1883, in a case wherein William & George McMillen plaintiff and Erastus V.
