I, *Daniel Braden Jr* Sheriff of *Stable* County, in the State of Indiana, certify that I have this day sold by virtue of *Certified Copy of Judgment, decree and order of sale* to me directed from the Clerk of *The Circuit* Court of *Stable* County, Indiana, issued on the *13th* day of *January* 1886, in a case wherein plaintiff and *Barbara Stahl, Rheubm Stahl and George Stahl* are

defendant, wherein judgment was rendered on the *eight* (*8th*) day of *December* 1885, for the sum of *One hundred and Seventy five* (*175*) dollars and *Sixty four* (*64*) cents, principal and interest to date of judgment, and the further sum of *Seventeen* (*17*) dollars and *five* (*05*) cents. costs accrued to that date, upon which there has accrued interest and *Two* (*2*) dollars and *Seven* (*7*) cents costs making in all *one hundred and Seventy seven* (*177*) dollars and *Seventy one* (*71*) cents, principal and interest, and *Thirty nine* (*39*) dollars and *fifteen* (*15*) cents costs to date of sale: making total amount due *Two hundred and sixteen* (*216*) dollars and *eighty six* (*86*) cents. And the said *Daniel Braden Jr* as Sheriff aforesaid, advertised for sale, according to law, or levied said
